



Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative(GMEC) is proud to partner with Generac's Energy Alliance Program which offers exclusive savings on generators for our members. GMEC offers a generator program for members to purchase a Generac® standby generator which is professionally installed by certified Generac Technicians through our partnership with local certified installers. Standby units' exclusive savings will be passed on from GMEC to the member through our local install partnership.

For those members who don't have a need for a whole-home generator, or for those who don't want to make that level of investment, we offer the ability to purchase Generac portable units.

GMEC also offers the GenerLink™ transfer switch from Global Power Products. A GenerLink is a meter base mounted transfer switch. GenerLink transfer switches provide a safe and convenient way to connect a portable generator power to your home in minutes during a power outage. GenerLink comes with a 20ft a cord.

GenerLink and portable units will be purchased directly through GMEC.

*For added convenience, members who purchase a portable generator and GenerLink as a bundled package are eligible for delivery by GMEC.

The purpose of our generator program is not to address reliability concerns, but to help members be better prepared for unexpected outages. It provides an additional layer of resilience for situations that are often caused by factors beyond the cooperative's control, including storms and other emergencies.

Step 1

Standby Units- Contact our local install partner for a consultation. Members may also consult with our Energy Advisor to review their energy use and determine which generator best fits their needs.

Portable Units- Contact Member Services to place your order or to receive a quote on their preferred unit. Members can also consult with our Energy Advisor to review their energy demand and determine which generator best fits their needs.

Step 2

Standby Units- Following the consultation, the install partner will order the unit from GMEC and pass the savings directly on to the member for installation. Financing is available through the installation partner.

Portable Units- Once the order has been placed and the unit has been delivered to the cooperative, members will be contacted for pick up. Members will pay for the unit upon pick up. GMEC accepts cash, money order, check, or credit card.

Step 3

Standby Units- Once installation is complete, members may enroll in a maintenance plan, with their install partner, to help ensure reliable operation and maintain warranty coverage.

Portable Units- Members will be responsible for the assembly and maintenance of the unit.

Members participating in the Generator Program will be required to sign an agreement acknowledging the member's responsibility for the generator unit upon receipt and releasing all liability of the unit from GMEC.

It is the member's sole responsibility to register the product warranty directly with Generac after taking possession of the unit. All warranty claims, service requests, repairs, replacement requests, and warranty-related communications must be handled directly between the member and Generac.

GMEC does not register warranties on behalf of members and assumes no responsibility for warranty registration, warranty claims, repairs, replacements, maintenance, or any other service-related matters associated with the generator unit.

Once the generator unit leaves GMEC's office or designated distribution location, ownership, care, custody, and responsibility for the unit transfer entirely to the member.

Generator Pricing Information

Cooperative pricing cannot be advertised or published online.

Members interested in purchasing a generator through the cooperative are encouraged to contact GMEC directly and provide the Generac model number they are interested in. Upon request, GMEC will provide an exclusive member pricing quote for the specified unit.
