INSTRUCTIONS:

If you do not have Adobe Reader software, it is a free download available here: <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>. (If you do not want to install **McAfee Security Scan Plus** and **True Key™** by Intel Security, uncheck their boxes prior to downloading.)

1. **Open the application file using Adobe Reader, and save it.**
2. **Complete the first two pages using Adobe Reader.**
3. **Save the file again, then print all pages.**

Take the application to your guidance counselor to complete the faculty portion. It is preferred those sections are typewritten; however, they may be handwritten if necessary.

Include a typewritten essay of 500 - 1,000 words describing how you hope to make a positive impact in your life through your goals, future plans, and everyday interactions with others.

Application, letters of recommendation, and essay response must be received in the Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative office by 4:00 p.m. on February 6, 2026.

GMEC SCHOLARSHIP IN HONOR OF JERRY KACKLEY 2026

RULES:

To be eligible for the GMEC scholarships, the following provisions will govern the acceptance of applicants:

1. Applicants must be the child or legal ward of a Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative member.
2. Applicants must be graduating seniors who have all basic credits for college or proper vocational or technical school entrance.
3. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale or an equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale.
4. Winners must be accepted and then enrolled in an accredited college or proper vocational/technical school of students' choice when they receive the award.
5. Members of the immediate families and persons residing in the households of directors, cooperative employees of GMEC or affiliated organizations are not eligible to apply.
6. Applications must be submitted (typed to be accepted) on forms furnished by and submitted to **Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative, Inc.**
7. Applicants who have not submitted applications to the cooperative by its deadline will not be eligible.
8. Application information must be confined to the official nomination form with only grade transcripts, a letter of recommendation, and an essay response attached. Letters of recommendation should be no longer than 500 words.
