### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

If you do not have Adobe Reader software, it is a free download available here: <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>. (If you do not want to install McAfee Security Scan Plus and True Key™ by Intel Security, uncheck their boxes prior to downloading.)

1. **Open the application file using Adobe Reader, and save it.**
2. **Complete the first two pages using Adobe Reader.**
3. **Save the file again, then print all pages.**

Take the application to a teacher and your guidance counselor to complete the faculty portion. It is preferred those sections are typewritten; however, they may be handwritten if necessary.

**Applications and letters of recommendation must be received in the Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative, office by 4:00 p.m. on February 5, 2021. Scholarship interviews (tentatively) will be held on February 20, 2021. Applicants will receive additional information in the mail prior to that date.**

In order to carry on an educational and training program that encourages Ohio's rural youth to further their education and gives them an opportunity to become more aware of careers in the rural electric program.

## **CHILDREN OF MEMBERS SCHOLARSHIP 2021**

### **RULES:**

To be eligible for the GMEC scholarships, the following provisions will govern the acceptance of applicants:

1. Applicants must be the child or legal ward of a *Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative* member.
2. Applicants must be graduating seniors who have all basic credits for college or proper vocational or technical school entrance. A “proper vocational or technical school” is defined as a post-secondary institution where credits can be transferred to a state accredited four-year college.
3. Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or above on a 4.0 scale or an equivalent standing on a nontraditional scale. Winners must provide proof of enrollment in an accredited college in order to claim their scholarship. Applicants, who are accepted and then enrolled in an accredited school of nursing, working toward a degree, are also eligible.
4. Applicants *may not* be immediate family members of, or reside with, people who are employed by *any* electric cooperative in Ohio (employees, trustees, managers, OEC, *or* affiliated organizations such as Buckeye Power, Inc., RESCO, Cardinal Operating Company, etc.) .
5. Applications must be submitted (typed to be accepted) on forms furnished by Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative, Inc. **Applications must be received in the Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative office by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 5, 2021.** Application information must be confined to the official nomination form. The only attachments permitted are transcripts, **ONE** teacher recommendation and a photo of the student.
6. Students are not permitted to bring any outside materials to their interviews (e.g., electronic presentations, props, handouts, etc.).
7. If the first-place winner does not meet Ohio Electric Cooperative’s eligibility requirements including being a permanent residential electric cooperative member receiving service for the duration of the 2020-21 academic year (August 2020 - June 2021) or receives a “full-ride” scholarship (ie., scholarships that cover the cost of tuition, room, board and books) to the school of his/her choice, he/she will not be eligible to compete at the statewide level. Applicants who win an OEC scholarship and subsequently receive a full-ride scholarship following the Children of Members scholarship competition, must contact OEC immediately to forfeit this scholarship.
8. All scholarships must be accepted in the first academic year after proof of enrollment is received by OEC. However, an extension of one year may be granted for just cause in the judgment of the president of OEC. In the event students are unable to fulfill their enrollment obligation under this program, the awards are forfeited.
