## What's behind your dryer?

Tips for cleaning ducts and saving money on your bill

HAVE YOU EVER LOOKED behind your clothes dryer? Are you scared to?

In my many home energy audits, I have seen some bad ones. But I'm not talking about ten years of accumulation of lost socks (the washer didn't eat them after all), loose change, dryer sheets, or the herd of dust bunnies. I'm referring to your dryer vent and proper maintenance of it and your dryer. Just as an automobile needs proper maintenance to run well and save fuel, your clothes dryer and vent need to be maintained to operate safely and correctly, as well as to save valuable electricity.

For your clothes to get dried properly, the clothes dryer combines heat with air flow through the wet laundry. If you don't have proper air flow, bad things will happen. I have found dryers that were running three times as long as they should to get clothes dry. That means three times the electric use, three times the wear on the clothes, a three times shorter life for your dryer, and a large increase in

the chance of losing your home to a fire.

According to reports by the Consumer Product Safety Commission, in one year, 16,800 dryer fires caused 30 deaths, 430 injuries, and over 967 million dollars in property damage. Therefore, we should be very motivated to roll up our sleeves and start investigating why.

First of all, let's define the problem and its causes. We have to get the hot, humid, lint-

filled air away from the dryer. According to U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission research, a 75 percent blocked dryer exhaust duct elevates the exhaust air temperature of the average electric dryer 89 percent more than its normal operating temperature with an unplugged duct. A clean lint screen only removes a portion of the lint that's exiting the dryer. The rest of the lint tends to catch on any restriction it encounters on the way outside the home. First is the connector pipe to the wall. Many flexible pipes have too much ribbing, bends, and

kinks that restrict air flow and catch lint. Then, many of today's homes have long runs of vent ducts in walls, floors, basements, or crawl spaces. Finally, lint tends to build up in the termination hood or damper, especially if it has an insect or animal screen.

Now we need to fix the problem. The entire length

of vent needs to be cleaned out. Take it apart anywhere you can, and use brushes and a Shop-Vac® to clean it out. I have read that a leaf blower at one end and a vacuum at the other work well on longer pipes. Some HVAC contractors also offer this service. Consider replacing the transition duct (dryer to wall) if it's flexible with a lot of ribbing, kinks, and bends. It is better to use smooth, rigid pipe or a

periscope-type connector to eliminate places for lint to catch. Definitely use rigid, smooth vent ducts to run longer distances between floor joists, in basements, and in crawl spaces.

Some other rules and guidelines:

- Never exhaust into attics, crawl spaces, basements, chimneys, or interior spaces.
- Dryer duct must be at least four inches in diameter.
- Keep length of dryer exhaust duct to 25 feet maximum. Decrease by

five feet for every 90-degree bend.

- Do not use fasteners that extend into the airway, such as screws or rivets. They catch lint. Use foil duct tape at seams.
- Outside termination must have a back draft damper, which keep out moisture, air, and small critters. The termination must not have a screen covering the exhaust outlet.

Be sure to thoroughly clean the entire length of your dryer duct as often as possible. When too much lint gathers, you use more electricity and increase your risk of a house fire.

## OFFICIAL NOTICE MEDICAL CERTIFICATION

Medical certification forms are available upon request at the Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative, Inc. office for those persons who must certify that disconnection of electric service would make the operation of necessary medical equipment impossible or impracticable, or that such discontinuation of electric service would otherwise be dangerous to the health and welfare of persons residing in the household.

In all cases where discontinuation of service would be especially dangerous to the life and welfare of the occupants within a household, the consumer should contact the cooperative and request a "Medical Certification" form. This form must then be completed and certified by a licensed physician or local board of health and filed with the cooperative.



### Follow these tips for safe, efficient use of your clothes dryer:

- Avoid partial loads.
- Never overload the dryer air cannot get through the clothes adequately.
- Clean the lint screen after every use; if fabric softener is used, occasionally wash the screen with soap and water.
- Periodically, use the long tip of your vacuum cleaner to remove lint collecting below the lint screen in the lint screen slot of your clothes dryer.
- Consider drying clothes on a clothes line (solar power) or a drying rack. This is easier on clothes and uses no electricity.
- Occasionally clean out the dryer exhaust vent pipe.

### OFFICIAL NOTICE

**Certification of Active Duty Deployment** 

**Guernsey-Muskingum** Electric Cooperative, Inc.

The cooperative will not disconnect electric service to the residential premises of any residential member who is deployed on active duty for nonpayment for electricity provided to the residential premises. Upon return of the residential member from active duty, the cooperative will offer the residential member a period equal to at least the period of deployment on active duty to pay any arrearages incurred during the period of deployment. If the period the cooperative offers the residential member for repayment presents a hardship, the member may request a longer period to repay the arrearages. No late payment fees or interest will be charged to the residential member during the period of deployment or the repayment period.

"Active duty" means active duty pursuant to an executive order of the president of the United States, an act of the congress of the United States, or section 5919.29 or 5923.21 of the Ohio Revised Code

The residential member must resume the timely payment of all charges for electric service provided by the cooperative after the return from active duty deployment.

In order to avoid disconnection of electric service for nonpayment for electric service during a period of active duty deployment, a completed Certification of Active Duty Deployment form must be submitted to the cooperative. Certification of Active Duty Deployment forms are available from the cooperative upon request.

## **Breaking free:**

Experience the

power of the horse

Along the winding roads of Muskingum County lies the village of Norwich, which is home to the Breaking Free Therapeutic Riding Center. Breaking Free is a nonprofit Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship (PATH) Premier Center member that provides therapeutic equine services to individuals in need, including veterans and those with disabilities. These therapeutic services provide countless benefits, such as improved coordination, balance, posture, strength, confidence, and behavioral health.

Linda and Bryan Lake started Breaking Free in 2008 with the intention of serving children with disabilities in a unique and lasting way. After beginning at their own farm using their own horses, they have now grown to become a large outdoor facility, complete with 19 specially trained horses. They are also working to build their own indoor riding arena.

The program operates solely through donations, fundraising, and individuals who volunteer with the goal of helping people from their own community grow and gain independence.

It's impossible not to notice how special Breaking Free is, and the organization has particularly captured the interest of Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative. GMEC administers Operation Helping Others (OHO), which allows GMEC members to round up their monthly electric bills to the next dollar, donating the spare change into the OHO fund.





OHO then awards grants to worthy local organizations. Breaking Free happens to be one of the most successful organizations that OHO has helped.

OHO has an annual limit of \$2,500 per applicant, which has allowed the program to donate about \$8,900 to Breaking Free over the past several years, supporting the organization as it grows. The Lakes stressed that Breaking Free cannot operate and help individuals in need without caring and generous donors, and GMEC's OHO recognizes this.

"This story is a success.
Breaking Free has been growing for eight to 10 years and looks to have a strong future," said Brian Bennett, GMEC's manager of marketing and member services. "Though dreams like these often fall short of funds and passion with time, this one perseveres."

The Lakes, Breaking Free volunteers, and families of the riders have dedicated their lives to providing a safe and supportive horse-riding facility for individuals of all ages. This type of dedication should be recognized endlessly — everyone should get the chance to "experience the power of the horse," as Breaking Free's motto goes. &

## Want to help build an indoor riding arena?

Breaking Free is currently leasing an indoor riding facility in Zanesville, but is raising money to build its own indoor arena on Linda and Bryan Lake's grounds in Norwich.
